Prof LEE Chack Fan, GBS, JP (李焯芬教授)

In the 1960's, Prof Lee was a volunteer for the Hong Kong College students Social Service Team, building roads and bridges. While in Canada, he was a volunteer for the Mon Sheong Home for the Aged and the Mon Sheong Foundation Chinese School. He is now a volunteer with the Fuhui Charity Foundation, supporting rural education, public health and orphan care in mountainous Western China.

He is also the Chairman of the Board of the Hong Kong Institute for Promotion of Chinese Culture; Chairman of the Council of the Lord Wilson Heritage Trust; member of the Board of the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority. He is currently the Director of HKU School of Professional and Continuing Education and Chair Professor of Geotechnical Engineering.



The Hon Charles LEE Yeh Kwong, GBM, GBS, JP (李業廣先生)

Mr Lee is one of the founders of the solicitors' firm of Woo Kwan Lee & Lo, a major law firm in Hong Kong. He served as a member of the Executive Council of Hong Kong; Chairman of the Council of the Open University of Hong Kong; Chairman and advisor of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority; Chairman of Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited; Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Hong Kong Arts Festival Society Limited. He is currently Chairperson of Hong Kong – Taiwan Economic and Cultural

Co-operation and Promotion Council and Chairman of Audit Profession Reform Committee of Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Mr Lee also participates actively in community service. Currently he remains as Board Member and Campaign Committee Co-Chairman with The Community Chest of Hong Kong.

Dr the Hon LEONG Che Hung, GBM, GBS, OBE, JP (梁智鴻醫生)

Dr Leong is a doctor in private practice, specialised in urology. Dr Leong is active in public services and he has been a non-official member of the Executive Council HKSAR. He is currently the Chairman of Council of The University of Hong Kong; the Hong Kong Aids Foundation and the Elder Academy Development Foundation. Dr Leong was the former Chairman of the Elderly Commission HKSAR. He pays particular attention to the needs of elderly, while advocating the senior citizens to live fruitfully their later years.



Dr the Hon David LI Kwok Po, GBM, GBS, JP (李國寶爵士)

Dr Li has devoted much of his working life to public causes, particularly in education, social services and training. He is presently Pro-Chancellor of the University of Hong Kong; Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Salvation Army Hong Kong and Macau Command; and Chairman of the St. James Settlement, among other commitments. He served as a member of the Legislative Council of Hong Kong from 1985 to 2012, and as Chairman of the Hong Kong Management Association from 1983 to 2012. He was a Vice-Patron of the Community Chest, and has served on numerous other public bodies and committees, contributing enormously to the social and economic development of Hong Kong. Dr Li is Chairman and Chief Executive of The Bank of East Asia, Limited. The Bank provides many opportunities to enable staff members to engage in volunteer work, and has established a corporate volunteer team to promote volunteerism.

Dr Donald LI, SBS, OStJ, JP (李國棟醫生)

Dr Li is a specialist in Family Medicine in private practice. He is the President of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine, the President of the World Organization of Family Doctors Asia Pacific region and Censor of the Hong Kong College of Family Physicians. Dr Li is the Chairman of Bauhinia Foundation Research Centre. He is also a steward of the Hong Kong Jockey Club, member of the St. John's Ambulance Council and member of Hong Kong Council on Smoking & Health. He is the Chairman of the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui Welfare Council, serves on the committee of the Community Care Fund Task Force under the Commission of Poverty and an appointed member of the Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council. He serves on the steering committee of Food & Health Bureau on strategic review on healthcare planning & professional development as well as the Manpower Steering Committee of the Hong Kong Government.



Mr LO Lok Fung, Kenneth (羅樂風先生)

Mr Kenneth Lo Lok Fung is the Chairman of the Crystal Group which was founded with his wife Yvonne Lo in 1970. Mr Lo has over the years transformed the traditional garment manufacturing business into a dynamic, progressive and competitive enterprise. In recognition of his visionary and innovative business leadership, he received the distinguished Hong Kong Industrialist of the Year Award 2012.

Mr Lo actively contributes and participates in the promotion of education, social responsibility and charitable services both in Hong Kong and China. He financially supported the Agency for Volunteer Service's Hopeful School Project from 1997 to 2011. The Crystal Group has a strong dedicated team of volunteers to support its charitable volunteer services. Mr Lo has recently assisted in the establishment of a Volunteers Association in China and is interested in the promotion of volunteering its professional management, expertise and in particular sustainable development to achieve the ultimate goals of a civil society.

Dr Stephen RIADY (李棕博士)

Dr Riady is the Chairman of Lippo Limited and the President of the Lippo Group of Companies. As the Patron and Trustee of the Volunteer Service Trust, he has made substantial contribution to the Trust, and supported the activities of the Hong Kong Council of Volunteering and the Agency for Volunteer Service. In 2010, Lippo Group set up a corporate volunteer team.

Dr Riady is active in serving the community. This includes such engagements as Founding Honorary Advisor of the University of Hong Kong Foundation for Education Development and Research; and member of the Advisory Board of the Sloan School of Management, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA.
